

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A TRAINED MEDIATOR?

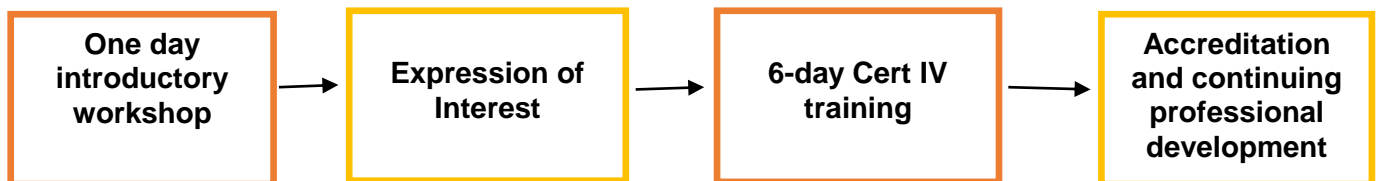
